For the last several years, we have worked hard encouraging our parents to respond to the annual Assurance Survey and we are pleased with our current results particularly when compared to the provincial response rate for grade 10 parents. Overall, we continue to seek ways to improve our instruction thereby increasing the number of our students performing at the excellent level as measured by the Diploma Exam scores.

This year, we revamped our existing student-at-risk tracking in order to ensure that our senior high students, regardless of grade, are on track to meet graduation requirements. We anticipate our 3-year completion rate to return to acceptable/previous levels in the coming year.
